



Future Stars Summer Camp

We are pleased to confirm that the first Future Stars Summer Camp will be held over the weekend of 5th August at St Sampson's School. The times are as follows:

Friday	4th August	6.30pm-8pm
Saturday	5th August	9.30am-4pm
Sunday	6th August	9.30am-4pm

The camp is open to school years 6, 7 & 8 and aims to give children a camp-style feel, including a wide range of basketball elements over an intense weekend period. The participants will gain knowledge of the game through training and tutorials, learn new skills and drills through our "stations" and experience game play through team orientated sessions with a dedicated coach each day. They will then put this into practice through game play during the afternoon, culminating in finals day on the Sunday afternoon. There will also be competitions and prizes as well as an end of camp "evaluation" for each participant. Each participant will need a pack lunch for the Saturday and Sunday sessions and will receive a camp T-shirt.

- Participants should have their Future Stars vest with them for games
- There will be LOTS of running around and it will be a tiring experience for some
- The camp will be led by Pat Ogier and assisted by Senior and Junior Island players.
- The aim as always will be to have a lot of fun!
- Cost £80 per participant (14.5 hours coaching, T-shirt & evaluation)

- Future Stars will not accept responsibility for young people who arrive prior to the scheduled start time or remain on site after the scheduled finish time.
- Future Stars would like to take pictures of your child taking part in any of our sessions. The photos may be used for publicity purposes; either/ or in local news or Future Stars promotional materials. Participants may be asked to give a radio or TV interview in which case all images and interviews will be taken in line with the GBA/Future Stars Safeguarding Children Policies.

ABOUT OUR COACHES

- Our coaches are experienced players and coaches from the Guernsey Basketball Association, first aid qualified and enhanced background checked.
- All coaches are aware and understand the GBA/Future stars Safeguarding Children Policy which is available upon request.
- A first aider will always be on site.

COACHING

- Led by Guernsey Basketball Association Coaches and Island Players supported by assistants. The programme of coaching is based on England Basketball's Core Coaching topics and the six stages and underlying principles of Long Term Player Development (LTPD)

INFORMATION

- Participants must wear suitable clothing (shorts / tracksuit trousers / t-shirt) and footwear (basketball specific shoes or trainers), and bring a drink with them.
- Pack lunches are required for both the Saturday and Sunday sessions.
- The camp will require a fair amount of physical exercise and participants should be aware of that prior to sign up. Regular rest periods and drink breaks will be factored in, as well as time for lunch but we aim to pack as much play into the weekend as possible!
