

Guernsey Basketball Association (“GBA”)

Privacy Notice

The GBA is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your membership, the GBA is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with the GBA as a member. The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, name of the affiliated Clubs with which you are registered and gender. We may also ask for relevant health information, emergency contact details and clothing sizes for specific events, for which we will independently request your authority.

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your Basketball Data is to be able to administer your membership, and provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register. Our lawful basis for processing your personal information is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a member to provide the services you are registering for, in this case providing a structure in which to play competitive basketball.

Reasons we may need to process your data include:

For training and league entry

- sharing personal data with club coaches or officials to administer training sessions;
- sharing personal data with club team managers to enter events;
- sharing personal data with facility providers to manage access to the court; and
- sharing personal data with leagues, England Basketball and the Guernsey and International Island Games Association and other competition providers for entry into authorised events.

For membership and club management

- processing of membership forms and payments;
- sharing data with committee members to provide information about club activities, membership renewals or invitation to social events;
- publishing of fixture & competition results.

Marketing and communications (where separate consent is provided)

- sending information about promotions and offers from sponsors;
- sending information about selling club kit, merchandise or fundraising.

Any special category health data we hold on you is only processed for the purpose of passing health data to coaches to allow the safe running of training sessions and in the case of England Basketball and the Island Games Association, where it is specifically requested for insurance purposes. We process this data on the lawful basis of consent. Therefore, we will also need your explicit consent to process this data, which we will ask for at the point of collecting it.

On occasion we may collect personal data from non-members, such as any non-member participant who fills in a health disclaimer or form at a taster event run by the GBA. This information will be stored for 60 days after the event and then destroyed securely. Our lawful basis for processing data is consent. Therefore, we will also need explicit consent from non-members to process this data, which we will ask for at the point of collecting it.

The GBA has the following social media pages - Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram as well as a website. All members are free to join these pages. If you join one of the Social Media pages, please note that provider of the social media platforms have their own privacy policies and that the GBA does not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data on the club social media pages.

Who we share your personal data with

When you become a member of the GBA, you will also automatically be registered as a member of Basketball England. We will provide Basketball England with your Basketball Data which they will use to enable access to the membership portal. The GBA does not supply any personal data it holds for this purpose to any other third party. The GBA does not store or transfer your personal data outside of Guernsey and the UK with the exception of instances where you are chosen to represent your island at the Island Games, where necessary data will be provided to the organising committee of the host island for competition purposes. Processing of this data will require your further consent.

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data on file for as long as you are a member with us. Data is updated every year on annual membership forms. Any personal data we hold on you will be securely destroyed after four years of inactivity on that member's account, in line with the GBA's retention policy as suggested by Basketball England. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the GBA. If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
