Code of Practice for Junior Members

As a member of The GBA, you are expected to abide by the following junior code of practice:

1. Compliance with Rules:

 All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.

2. Respect for Others:

 All members must respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs, or sexual identity.

3. Punctuality:

 Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.

4. Appropriate Attire:

Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.

5. Timely Payment:

• Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.

6. No Smoking:

Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or while representing the club at competitions.

7. No Alcohol or Drugs:

Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or while representing the club.
