Code of Practice for Club Officials and Volunteers



GUERNSEY BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All volunteers must:

1. Prioritise Well-being and Safety:

 Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.

2. Build Trust and Respect:

• Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants based on mutual trust and respect.

3. Tailor Activities to Participants:

• Ensure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability, and experience of those taking part.

4. Promote Positive Aspects:

Promote the positive aspects of the sport, such as fair play.

5. Maintain High Standards:

Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.

6. Adhere to Guidelines:

 Follow all guidelines laid down by the National Governing Body and the club.

7. Possess Qualifications and Insurance:

Hold appropriate valid qualifications and insurance cover.

8. Avoid Undue Influence:

 Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward.

9. **Discourage Rule Violations:**

 Never condone rule violations, rough play, or the use of prohibited substances.

10. Value Performances over Results:

 Encourage participants to value their performances and not just results.

11. Encourage Responsibility:

• Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.

By adhering to this Code of Practice, club officials and volunteers contribute to creating a positive and safe environment for all participants in Guernsey Basketball.
